

### **SERMI – About SERMI**

- Established based on the recommendation of the report issued by the EU Forum established under Article 13 of the Euro 5/6 Regulation (EC) 692/2008 and Art. 66 of the Regulation (EU) 2018/858
- Founded by ACEA, AIRC, CECRA, FIA and FIGIEFA and advises the European Commission
- In charge of setting up and maintaining a scheme + appointing a Trust Centre
- It will assist Member States to implement SERMI at national level
- CECRA holds co-chair representing independent operators

### SERMI – Background

SERMI

- Euro 5/6 & Type Approval Regulations 

  OEMs to give unrestricted & standardised access to repair
   maintenance information (RMI) to Independent Operators (IO)
- Access to the vehicle security features → specific provisions
- Legislation provides access to security-related RMI shall be made available to IO, under the protection
  of
  - a) security standards & security certificates
  - b) IO to be approved & authorized
- Creation of SERMI
- Firm negotiations on Type Approval Regulation regarding Emission Tampering

#### Draft text:

'Operators shall not be considered to conduct a legitimate business activity where they perform, assist, offer or advertise repair or maintenance operations on a vehicle which may negatively affect its emissions, including but not limited to:

#### Final text:

'For the purposes of that procedure, operators shall not be considered to pursue a legitimate business activity where they advertise or offer repair or maintenance operations that would negatively impact the emissions performance of the vehicle. This shall include:





# SERMI – What is at stake

SERMI

### As of August first, 2023 without SERMI certificate

- You will not be able to perform software updates/installation on anti-theft related parts/software!
- Also if only a part of the ECU (control unit) is linked to anti-theft, the full ECU will be locked!
- Online ordering of anti-theft related parts will **not be possible**!

# Action at national level is required!





# SERMI – Need to be ready by August 2023

SERMI

- July 2021 Delegated Regulation (Annex X of the 2018/858) with SERMI amendment published in Official Journal of the European Union
- From that moment on a 2-year implementation period starts and SERMI scheme be in effect from August 2023

It sounds like a lot of time to implement SERMI, but during this period a lot of work must be done to setup SERMI at both European and national level

At EU level the SERMI organisation is working hard on selecting a Trust Centre (for supplying the certificates) and updating the SERMI-scheme




# SERMI – Independent Operators (workshops)

SERMI

- One certificate for all brands
- Applicable for vehicle types M, N and O (Cars, Vans, Trucks and Trailers)
- Access to Anti-theft R&M Information ONLY with Certificate + Multi Factor Authentication
- Accreditation Independent Workshop & Employee by Conformity Assessment Body (CAB)
  - Automotive related business activities
  - Clean criminal record for company & employee (e-availability)
  - No advertisement and sales activities on emission tampering related services
  - Approval company is linked to accreditation employee
- Duration period certificate 5 years, unless revoked due to misuse


An authorised repairer working on other brands is also seen as an Independent Operator

# SERMI – Conformity Assessment Body (CAB)

SERMI

#### Tasks:

- Approve Independent Operators (IOs) and employees
- Pseudonymization of personal data from IO employee
- Investigate claims for misuse
- Revokes approval and authorization if required
- Communication with Trust Centre
- On-site inspection IOs during validation period

#### Requirements:

- Accredited by National Accreditation Body (ISO 17020 Type A & SERMI Scheme)
- Ability to establish secure communication with the Trust Centre

Multiple CABs per country are possible/desired












# SERMI – Basic set up

# SERMI – National Accreditation Body

SERMI

#### Tasks:

- Approve Conformity Assessment Bodies
- Investigate claims for abuse by CAB
- Revokes approval CAB if required
- Spanish NAB must approve SERMI-Scheme








### SERMI – What shall national associations do?


- 1. Start to discuss SERMI & inform your members & other stakeholders
- 2. Inform your NAB (<u>find your national NAB</u>) about the upcoming "SERMI Regulation" so they can request information about the SERMI process from the European Accreditation Association (EA);
- 3. Seek potential CABs (need to comply with "ISO 17020:2012 Type A" standard) it takes  $\pm$  3 9 months for a CAB to be accepted by the NAB (there should be at least one approved CAB available in each MS). If CAB is a new company, setting up as an approved CAB takes  $\pm$  2 years
- 4. Inform workshops regarding necessity of SERMI-certificate and how to obtain it

SERMI

@National level - the access to anti-theft information & parts ordering will be closed for workshops


Workshops will not be able to:


- Programming keys/locks;
- Update Anti-Theft related software. This will include related software units (combined ECUs);
- Online Ordering Anti-Theft related parts.








# Hur får IO tillgång till säkerhetsrelaterad RMI i praktiken
